

## ***Certificate of Completion: Human Subjects Research Protection Training***

***Training is free and takes 3-4 hours.***

October 6, 2025

Take the Human Research Protections Training ("CIRTification Online") and obtain a Certificate of Completion:

Go to internet site, [CIRTification](https://ccts.uic.edu/resources/cirtification/online/), which is a free online training offered by the University of Illinois, Chicago. Go to that link and click on "Enroll in CIRTification." (see screenshot below). Then you will need to register, and to enroll.

This will take about 3.5 hours total. After passing the quiz at the end, download the certificate as a pdf and include it in your IRB application. Name the pdf, "*your last name* – Ethics Certificate". Certificates are required for all members of the research team.

Previous certificates (e.g., through ACRP) are acceptable, but as of today, all certificates must be less than 60 months old (from the date of the application). (It is best practice to periodically update and refresh researcher knowledge in this area).
